LOCAL RULES

- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)**
 - Beyond any hedges, fences or walls marking the boundary of the course.
 - In or over cutting defining machinery enclosure.
 - Beyond the line of white stakes separating the left of the 1st Hole from the Driving Range.
- WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**
 Water hazards are defined by Yellow Stakes.
- LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**
 Lateral water hazards are defined by Red Stakes.
- IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24)**
 - A ball coming to rest on or within one club-length of all artificially surfaced roads, pathways and stoned drainage areas.
 - Course furniture, supported trees including stay-wires and stakes, fixed markers and water system points.
 - All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty as follows:
 If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and

dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention and c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF ANY RULE:

Match Play – Loss of Hole;
 Stroke Play – Two Strokes.

OTHER

Metal Spikes are prohibited on the golf course. All measurements (scorecard, sprinkler head covers and 150 posts) are in Yards to the Centre of the Green. Players must repair ball marks, replace divots and rake bunkers.

In the interest of safety, it is not permissible to recover golf balls from lakes or cliff edges.

Obey the Course Ranger at all times. Maintain the traditional courtesy of the game by allowing faster groups to play through.
