Walk on the Wild Side with RTE Television Presenter, Dale Treadwell!

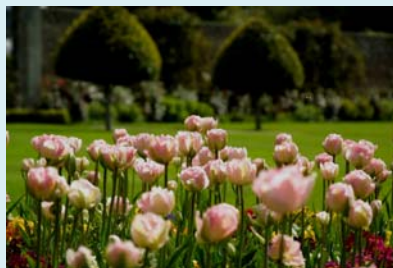
5th May: 4pm and repeated at 4.45 pm, Powerscourt Gardens
